

Appendix 4-2 Round 2 APEP Questions and Comments

Round 2 (2010) – Large Area Transportation Network Study, Route Identification

The purpose of Round 2 meetings was to provide results and feedback from Round 1 engagement activities to the local communities on the east side of Lake Winnipeg (with the exception of Norway House Cree Nation) and obtain additional input. Information collected was used to refine the preferred route option and to inform baseline environmental studies conducted for the EIS.
